**Parking**

**Parking is available to the side of the main entrance. There are no designated parking bays available. Access from the car park to the main entrance is available either via 11 steps (that are 'easy going' and have 'suitable treads', colour contrasting nosings and a handrail on one side ) OR via the public footpath.**

The main entrance door is a single automatic swing door. The door is not distinguishable.

### **Internal doors**

All doors are accessible.

### **Wheelchair accessible wc**

A wheelchair accessible wc is available within the entrance reception area. It is suitable for a manual wheelchair user. Sufficient space is available for both a frontal and a right hand transfer. Lighting is automatic, an alarm system is provided (activated by a pull cord) and handrails etc contrast in colour.
